Driver surrenders: A Capitol Heights man turned himself in yesterday to face a charge of negligent homicide in a hit-and-run Sunday that killed a woman on Kenilworth Avenue NE, police said.

Earl A. Johnson, 32, was driving with a suspended license when he struck **Arlene Carter**, 46, about 5:45 p.m. in the 1200 block of Kenilworth Avenue NE, police said. Johnson surrendered at the 6th Police District station in Northeast about 3:20 p.m. yesterday.

Carter, of the 4400 block of Ponds Street NE, was in a crosswalk when she was hit.
